Pacifica's Annual Earth Day Celebration to Raise Awareness of Sea Turtles, Saturday April 21st

WHAT:

The Pacifica Beach Coalition (PBC) is hosting its annual Earth Day celebration this Saturday, April 21st. In the morning, thousands of volunteers from across the Bay Area will participate in cleanups, habitat restoration, and beautification projects. In the afternoon, everyone is invited to a free, beachside Earth Day celebration with live music, presentations by state and local dignitaries and renowned sea turtle experts, refreshments, family activities, and educational exhibits.

This year PBC dedicates its Earth Day efforts to the ancient, yet threatened, sea turtle. In January, the National Marine Fisheries Service designated critical habitat for endangered leatherback sea turtles off the U.S. west coast, including 16,910 square miles off California's coast. In addition, a current state bill (AB1776) proposes to designate the leatherback sea turtle as California's official marine reptile. The "Be Turtley Cool, Take Action" Earth Day Celebration aims to raise awareness of these magnificent sea creatures and these national and state efforts to protect them.
